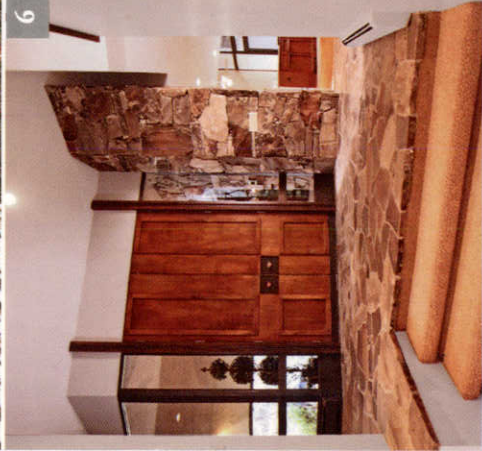

*Original custom home built for Dr. F. Temple Rieckhoff in 1975 by noted architect Eduard Dreier, AIA. The talented architect was invited by Oscar Niemeyer to study under him in Brazil, but stayed in Salt Lake City because of his aging parents, where he developed a strong reputation and built was once the largest firm in the city. To gain better control of construction process and attention to detail, Dreier eventually downsized his business to a select few clientele. From his early modern homes influenced by Richard Neutra to his later work of grand sculptural design, Dreier was always noted for bold geometric shapes, functional simplicity, and unsurpassed quality.*
